Together Under One Roof



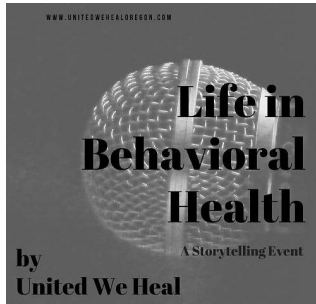
Together, Under One Roof, groups that work for social, racial, and environmental justice share their purpose, projects, stories, and work together to build a movement.
