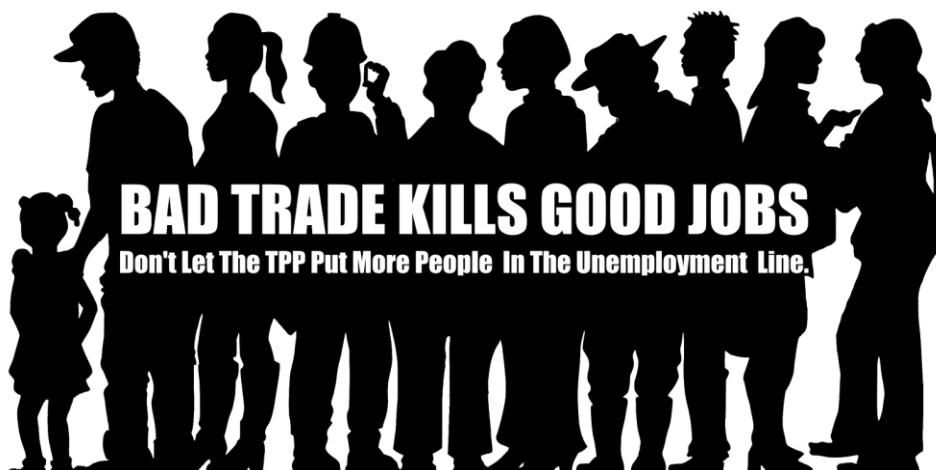
Don't Tread on Pride: No TPP!
