Support Kaiser Healthcare Workers: Informational Picket!



Healthcare workers at Kaiser Permanente Northwest are currently in contract talks with their employer. On Sunday, July 29, the [OFNHP](#) membership voted nearly unanimously to engage in informational picketing and leafleting at Kaiser facilities because of the significant challenges they're facing in bargaining with Kaiser both national and locally.

Kaiser is proposing to do away with pensions for all future employees, increase doctor visit and prescription co-pays by 400%, eliminate guaranteed hours, and has refused to address ongoing concerns around staffing and workload.

The informational picket will take place on **August 23 from 12-1p at the Kaiser Interstate Campus**, and **August 24 from 6:30-8am at the Kaiser Sunnyside Medical Center**.
